were at the funeral home, where an impromptu funeral was organized. We brought supplies, consoled Armando's

family, and I was able to share a message and pray.

I especially wanted to contact Armando's son Javier, because Armando died on his birthday. Javi said, "My dad gave me the best birthday present he could give me. I got to see my dad one last time. He was unconscious, but they brought him out of the Covid ward into the emergency ward, and I was able to spend the night at his side and talk to him. And he held on like a total gentleman, until my mother and sister were able to come back in the morning."

April conferences

April meant Spring Break from seminary teaching, which gave me time to accept two requests to give conferences by Zoom.

On Tuesday and Thursday nights for two weeks, I gave a conference on *Worldview and Postmodernism* to COMPA's team for the southeast of Mexico. Photo below. (COMPA is a university ministry associated with InterVarsity). I really enjoyed teaching that group.

On Friday nights for four weeks I gave a conference for the seminary on the topic of Books in the first century and today. I really enjoyed this. We looked at how very different reading, writing, publishing books were in the first century, as was the use of Scripture in the early church. Then we looked at the problems of biblical illiteracy, lack of reading, and book pirating in Mexico today. Given all the advantages we have over people in the first century (widespread literacy, as well access to inexpensive, high quality paper, ink and copies, not to mention computer and online tech for writing and reading), how can we once again become

"people of the book", let alone "people of the Book"?

As we mentioned in our February prayer letter, from July to December I will continue my team leader responsibilities but will suspend my other ministry activities to focus on investigating and producing Spanish
