Serious talk about money

As you know, we have made it our goal to avoid pressuring people for money. Our prayer letters focus on ministry and family. Our home visits are low pressure, friendly visits to catch up and to thank people for their prayers and support.

But I need to take a moment to talk about this topic, because we are being asked to raise

\$162,000 per year. This covers salary and benefits, housing and transportation, Reconnect travel and housing, our ministry budget, and my Mexico team leader budget. The last two years we were short by about \$24,000.

The mission is discouraging us from adding new supporting churches. And while a couple of our churches have pledged to increase their support this year, most of them are giving us \$4,000 or less. **So we need to focus on obtaining new individual donors.**

To fill the gap and reach our goal this year, we need the equivalent of 24 new donors at \$1,000 / year, or 40 new donors at \$50 / month, or 80 at \$25 / month.
